Asiamold Select – Guangzhou 2024 teams up with parallel exhibitions to reveal smart tech opportunities in moulding

Guangzhou, 25 January 2024. The Asiamold Select exhibition series will reconvene at the China Import and Export Fair Complex in Guangzhou, China from 4 – 6 March 2024. To be held concurrently with SPS – Smart Production Solutions Guangzhou and the debut edition of Guangzhou Industrial Technology, this interlinked trio of exhibitions will provide visiting moulders and mouldmakers with a comprehensive perspective of the smart technology trends that are reshaping the industry.

Offerings will include industrial communication, manufacturing software and IT systems, industrial robotics, intelligent equipment and intra-logistics, and more.

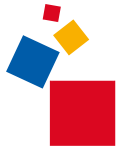
